Disciplinary Rules

All students come under the rules of the school from the start of their journey to school to the end of their journey back home.

All Pupils should, at all times maintain a high standard of manners, in their words and deeds.

Pupil should always be dressed in the prescribed school uniform or sports uniform, wherever applicable. Informal dress is permitted only on the child's birthday.

Pupil should reach the school before the first bell, at 9.00 am, **no late coming will be tolerated.** The students, who reach the school campus early, should be in their classrooms and spend their time in silent study.

Spoken English is compulsory within the school premises, in the school bus and at the bus stops while waiting to board the bus.

Students shall be responsible for the safe custody of their belongings. As a precautionary measure, it is suggested that they have their name inscribed on articles like Tiffin carriers, school bags, pencil boxes etc. The school authorities will not be responsible for the loss of articles by students.

At the first bell, both students and staff shall assemble class wise in the court-yard. On dispersal, the students move to their own classrooms in perfect order and in silence, together with their class teacher at the rear of the line.

When the teacher enters the class room, all students stand up to greet him/her and remain standing until they are asked to sit. They shall thank the teacher at the end of the class.

Students shall not leave their classroom during or in between the periods, but remain silent and prepare for the next period. They shall not enter any other classroom other than their own at any time. They should not bring valuable and curious articles, C.Ds, cell phones, books or magazines etc., to school that are not prescribed in the syllabus. They should not wear gold ornaments.

An atmosphere of silence must be maintained by everyone during working hours in the classrooms, staff room and office.

Lost articles must be claimed from the school office within a week, after which the unclaimed articles will be disposed off. Any damage caused to the property of the school must be immediately reported to the Principal and will have to be made good.

Classrooms and the school premises shall be kept neat and tidy. All waste paper must be put in the proper receptacle. Students must make it a point of picking up and disposing of litter to maintain the appearance of the school. They may always take care that display boards, walls, furniture, shelves, blackboard etc, are kept neat and in order.

No collection of any kind whatsoever, and no selling or buying of anything shall be done among the students or staff in the school premises. No meeting, party or picnic or any kind of organized school activity shall be arranged without the previous approval of the Principal. Parents are earnestly requested not to make any personal gifts to staff members.
